John and Vickie changed all that, acquiring the business in 1998, conducting an extensive renovation, and ultimately adding automatic scoring, new gutters, plus many other improvements.

Today, you'll typically find John out doing what he loves: running the place with an easy confidence; mingling with customers; or enjoying his "big dog" status as he happily takes on bowling challenges from the locals. But ask John and he'll tell you that things weren't always this pleasant—

Center owner John Woodford was at his wit's end. A 2nd-generation bowling professional with 18 years of expertise, serious tour experience, plus an unquenchable passion for the sport, he realized that his cherished Spare Time Lanes was sapping his energy.

John was spending as much as \$70,000 a year on parts and labor on his old 82-30 pinspotters, which were running at 60% efficiency, malfunctioning every night, and forcing him to irk players by moving them to other lanes. What's more, as the center's designated mechanic, he found that the old machines were monopolizing so much of his time that the game itself was starting to lose its luster.

So he went to see his local banker with one goal in mind. In his words, "Either I am going to get financing to upgrade my equipment or I'm going to hang it up."
