



74 PERFECT GAMES

Since 1968 the perfect games were 13 by women and 61 by men. Counting 5.332 bowlers that have played in 54 years of the World Cup and the fact that the first ever World Cup perfect game was in 1994, it still is a challenge to get to the podium.

29 COUNTRIES - 39 CITIES

In 54 years of the Bowling World Cup history the event travelled to 29 different countries visiting 39 different cities. Some venues liked the World Cup so much they hosted it more than once.





PAENG NEPOMUCENO

Paeng Nepomuceno keeps the record for the most victories by an individual. Paeng also is the male bowler who appeared the most at the World Cup - 16 times, beaten by one appearence by Aida Granillo - 17.

IRMA URREA

Irma Urrea from Mexico is the first Women Champion of the QubicaAMF Bowling World Cup History. It was 1972 in Hamburg, Germany when women bowlers joined the men on the tournament lanes for the first time at St. Paulii's Astrid Bowl. And Mexico, thanks to Irma Urrea, claimed it's first Bowling World Cup Trophy.
